



## CODE OF CONDUCT FOR TECHNICAL OFFICIALS

### As a responsible technical official I will:

- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every athlete and others involved in athletics and treat everyone equally.
- Place the welfare and safety of the athlete above performance.
- Be appropriately qualified, obtain CRB clearance, update licence and education when required by UKA and adhere to the terms of the technical officials licence
- Keep up to date with changes in the relevant competition rules and seek the advice of others if necessary
- Cooperate fully in the provision of fair and equitable conditions for the conduct of athletics events under the relevant rules of competition.
- Act in a decisive, objective but friendly manner and carry out duties in an efficient and non-abrasive manner.
- Act with dignity and display courtesy and good manners.
- Consistently promote positive aspects of the sport, never condone rule violations and challenge inappropriate behaviour and language by others.
- Be fully prepared for the officiating tasks assigned.
- Offer guidance and support to less experienced officials.
- Encourage and guide athletes to accept responsibility for their own performance and behaviour
- Maintain clear boundaries between friendship and intimacy and not conduct inappropriate relationships with athletes.
